## Dear Friends,

I am frequently asked about the long term success rate of the teen parents who participate in the programs at Florence Crittenton. At first glance this seems like a very straight forward question. But it soon becomes apparent that success for a young family can be measured in an infinite number of ways. Essentially, I believe what you – the donor – wants to know is – are the girls and babies living a healthier, more prosperous life than they would have been if they had not been at Florence Crittenton. The answer is a resounding yes.

Each teen mother that passes through the doors at Crittenton is unique. As such, she faces a unique journey on her way to independence and successful adulthood. Critical issues such as the physical process of maintaining a healthy pregnancy, catching up in school or learning career skills may supersede other very important goals for a period of time. *Every teen mother will need to cope with their own adolescent development and simultaneously take on the challenges of parenting.*

The successes we see in these resilient young women are nothing short of amazing. However, nearly all the teen parents in Crittenton programs will inevitably need to address the effects of a childhood trauma. **One of the outcomes of this early childhood trauma, among a complicated array of social, mental and health issues, is teen pregnancy.** A traumatized girl is more likely to experience an unplanned pregnancy before the age of 18. She is at risk for teen pregnancy because she may struggle with forming and identifying healthy relationships. While at Crittenton, she is learning the art of healthy relationships.

We are gaining valuable insight and strengthening our therapeutic approach with traumatized teens by utilizing the

findings from a groundbreaking study – the ACE study. The Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE) Study demonstrated that early childhood trauma has a long term effect on physical, emotional and social health.

**Trauma is a national health issue and unfortunately, it is common. But, the good news is, it is treatable.** Children and teens are capable of extraordinary resilience. This quality in children provides the ability to recover from trauma, respond to stress and maintain a sense of meaning, hope and identity. At Florence Crittenton we offer tools so teens can rely upon their own resilience, heal and become empowered to see a new way.

It is imperative to note that when a child is traumatized and abused it does not mean they will go on to abuse their child – in fact, 7 out of 10 will not repeat the abuse they suffered. They can be excellent parents.

So when I am asked about long term success of Crittenton clients, I am pleased to say they do very well. Do they sometimes struggle? Yes – just as your children might when they first leave home. Do they make mistakes? Absolutely! Are they more successful because their lives were touched by Florence Crittenton? Without a doubt. They have finished school, set their sights on higher goals, gained job skills, learned to parent, and been taught essential life skills. But most of all, they have begun the process of healing from the past so they can live in the present.

**Florence Crittenton is a national leader in helping teens lead healthy and productive lives and form secure and healthy attachments with their babies.**

## How You Know Us

Florence Crittenton has provided maternity care for young women for over a century. Our residential programs are the hallmark of our organization.

»»Our **Mother/Baby Program** is dually licensed as a therapeutic and maternity group home, serving pregnant and/or parenting teenagers ages 12-17 and their babies.

»»**Pathways to Success** provides transitional living for homeless, pregnant and parenting young women ages 16-21 in need of a place to live, support services and counseling.

»»**Independent Living Training (ILT)** teaches teen moms real life skills to survive in today's world, including: support to finish high school, budgeting, nutrition and cooking, education, job skills training, resume building, learning healthy hobbies and habits, and career exploration.

»»The **Child Enrichment Center** is a licensed Child Care Center for 12 infants and toddlers, including children of parents in the community, as well as our girls' babies.

Another cool thing Florence Crittenton has helped me do is get my own apartment through low-income housing. I am at the top of the waiting list for a two bedroom; I should be getting a call any day.

I could have never imagined these goals, let alone completing them, without the help of Florence Crittenton. I am truly thankful. I don't know where I would be without this awesome place!

**I am Ron Waterman, and my wife, Mignon, and I have been residents of Helena for more than 40 years. We both are involved in a number of community activities.**

In the early 1980's I was working with various social service agencies through United Way and my wife was involved with education through her service on the Helena School Board. At this time, we both began seeing how pregnant

and parenting single teen moms were struggling. We saw that once a young single woman became pregnant, this frequently led to the young woman dropping out of school and ending her education early. Struggling to parent an infant with interventions from other social service agencies often resulted in the removal of the child from the mother. This cycle of interrupted education, struggles with parenting, lower income employment or unemployment, and removal of the child from their birth parent created significant problems for the young mother, infant or child and the social service agencies which served these needs.

I became involved with the Florence Crittenton Home in the early 80's and then agreed to serve on the Board. In 2013, I will have served on the Board for 30 years. I found that Crittenton has effective programs to address the needs of pregnant teens and single young mothers and to break the cycle of parenting problems and poverty. My wife and I became supporters of the Florence Crittenton programs. Additionally, I serve on the National Crittenton Foundation, which provides national advocacy for the family of Crittenton agencies across the United States that address the needs of system involved and at-risk young women and their children.

During this last decade my wife and I have been fortunate enough to be able to make a deferred annuity gift to Florence Crittenton. This gift assures that the work Florence Crittenton does with young mothers, their babies and families will continue on for future generations; that the cycles of poverty, struggles with education, parenting and child abuse cease; and that all Montanans have the opportunity to have a healthy relationship between mother, child and the community.

I would urge you to consider making a planned gift to Florence Crittenton. Mignon and I chose a deferred annuity, but there are several different ways to plan a gift that keeps on giving for generations to come.
