## YOUTH MATERNITY HOME



Program Overview: A safe, nurturing residential program that supports pregnant and parenting youth by providing prenatal care, educational support, life skills training, and a trauma-informed therapeutic environment to help them build healthy, independent futures.

## WHAT'S INCLUDED: Housing (including all utilities), food, hygiene care and OTC medications for mom and baby Baby supplies as needed in partnership with placing agencies and parent Transportation 24/7 staff Mental health and SUD therapeutic services (group and individuals), and case management Recreation activities Community resource access Parenting skill, independent living skill development, and access to education

Length of Stay: 9-24+ months

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Must be pregnant, parenting, or working towards reunification.

Age range of mother: must be 12-20 years; age of children: 0-4 at admission, will accept children that will turn 5 during their stay with us.

A mental health or SUD diagnosis is not required.

May be a victim of crime, CPS-referred, juvenile probation, or self/family-referred.

## WHAT THE YOUTH MATERNITY HOME IS NOT:

The Youth Maternity Home is not a psychiatric hospital, or a therapeutic group home. Clients may have a mental health or SUD diagnosis (lower than a 3.1 ASAM diagnosis); however, we cannot accept clients with severe and frequent suicidal ideation, assault of a non-family member, severe run risk, or firestarting behaviors
